



Memorandum of Understanding

between

**concerning cooperation
in academic and cultural exchanges and scientific
research**

The University College of Enterprise and Administration in Lublin, Poland

and

The Faculty of Political Science and International Relations

Matej Bel University in Banská Bystrica, Slovak Republic

hereafter referred to as the “Participants”,

Wishing to develop bilateral cooperation regarding academic and cultural exchanges and scientific research activities, within the competence of the Participants,

Being aware that any cooperation activities must be conducted strictly in accordance with the respective law,

Have agreed as follows:

SECTION I

The objective of this Memorandum of Understanding, hereafter referred to as “the Memorandum” is to define the scope of the bilateral cooperation.

The bilateral cooperation will refer to:

- 1) exchange of students, faculty members and other staff;
- 2) culture promoting initiatives;
- 3) scientific research

in domains relevant to both Participants’ activities.

SECTION II

Bilateral cooperation of Participants may include, but shall not be limited to, the following forms:

- 1) an exchange of guest lecturers and speakers on mutually agreed subjects;
- 2) an exchange of faculty members within research and didactic programs;
- 3) an exchange of students within research and educational programmes; while implementing this provision students will be admitted upon requirements of the Host Participant;
- 4) implementation of joint research and didactic activities;
- 5) exchange of information on seminars, academic meetings, workshops etc. organised by either Participant;

- 6) common organisation of events listed in par. 4 of this Section, with a possible participation of other institutions;
- 7) an exchange of academic and research related materials (i.a. articles, publications); while implementing this provision no classified information shall be exchanged;
- 8) any other activities as mutually agreed by the Participants.

SECTION III

In implementing of activities under this Memorandum each Participant shall born all costs related to its representatives, unless otherwise agreed. This rule applies also to medical and dental care.

However, when either Participant invites guest speakers or lecturers from another Participant, costs of travelling, accommodation or board shall be borne by inviting Participant.

SECTION IV

This Memorandum shall enter into force on the date of signing and shall remain in force for an unlimited period unless it is terminated in accordance with provisions below.

This Memorandum may be terminated at any time by mutual written consent signed by both Participants. It may be also terminated by either Participant in a written notice given at least six months prior to an intended withdrawal from this Memorandum.

This Memorandum may be amended at any time by mutual written consent signed by both Participants. Such amendments, once approved by both Participants, shall become a part of this Memorandum.
